

Guardian Angel Cemetery invites you to honor our heroes and celebrate all veterans at our Memorial Day Mass

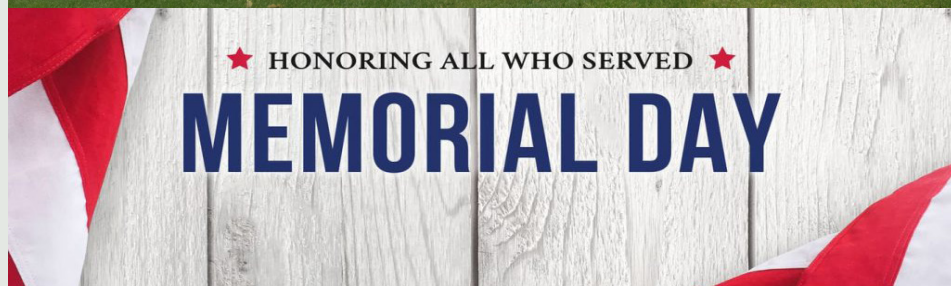
Memorial Day is one of the busiest days of the year at Guardian Angel Cemetery. We are proud to host our annual outdoor Memorial Day Mass starting at 8:30 a.m. on Memorial Day, which this year falls on Monday, May 27. We invite everyone in the community to attend the Mass officiated by Father Brian Chabala from St. Irenaeus in Rochester.

Throughout our Memorial Day Mass, we remember our family members, friends, colleagues and neighbors who served in the U.S. Military and helped to provide us with the freedoms that we cherish today.

At Guardian Angel we recognize these heroes in part through our Field of Honor, which includes more than 200 flags collectively honoring Michigan-based soldiers who were killed in the last two major U.S. wars in the Middle East.

A World War II Texas T fighter plane will conduct a memorial flyover just after Mass ends. Coffee and donuts from Knapp's Donut Shop in Rochester will also be served.

As we approach warmer weather, it is our ongoing effort to keep family members and their generations well informed of our decoration policy. Regulations for the personalization of memorial spaces vary throughout the cemetery.

To ensure the safety of all visitors as well as the ability to maintain the grounds, we ask all families to respect the policies in place. We've highlighted some of our regulations below. As always, our office staff is available to provide and review all cemetery regulations as well as those specific for your property. We invite you to share this information with any family or friends that may frequently visit.

Ground/Outdoor Burials

- All plants and decorations must be contained within the planting area.
- Potted plants are not permitted. Flowers may be planted, or cut flowers may be placed in a cone and staked within the planting area.
- One solar light 8" or shorter is permitted per grave.
- Artificial decorations such as silk flowers, garden statues, and glass items are not permitted.
- If you are unable to dispose of any debris accumulated while tending to the gravesite, please place it by the nearest section sign for our ground staff to collect.



Angel of Peace Mausoleum Burials

- All decorations must be contained within the vase, and may not encroach upon neighboring fronts.
- Please do not attach anything to the crypt or niche front.
- Silk or dried flowers may be used. For proper hygiene, fresh cut flowers are not permitted inside the mausoleum.
