Memorialize Your Loved One

The Garden of the Ascension at Resurrection allows individuals and families to have the unique option of adding a small epitaph to the crypt or niche front to memorialize your loved one, an option not available at other mausoleums in the cemetery.

The area around the Garden of the Ascension includes both an open area that allows for easy filtering of sunlight to covered areas to protect from the elements. We offer crypts and niches of two distinct colors of granite – Kenoran Sage and Mesabi Black, both of which are made from North American granite.



Features

The two features at Garden of the Ascension include the 24-foot Ascending Mosaic Monument that depicts Jesus Christ's ascension; and the nearly 9-foot Stain Glass Rose that includes a sunburst rose design with rich yellows, purples, blues, and reds.

Benefits of a Mausoleum

Demand has been high for crypts and niches at Resurrection Cemetery and spaces in our other indoor and outdoor mausoleums is limited. The Garden of the Ascension allows family members to experience the outdoor beauty of the environment, from sunlight to snowfall, while having a crypt or niche front that celebrates the life of an individual or couple.

With more than 300 acres, Resurrection Cemetery is one of the largest cemeteries in Michigan. A specific feature of Resurrection Cemetery is the specially commissioned artwork that can be found throughout the grounds and mausoleums. These include heroic-sized, bronze Stations of the Cross sculptures in section 21, and monumental bronze castings of religious figures found in some mausoleums.
